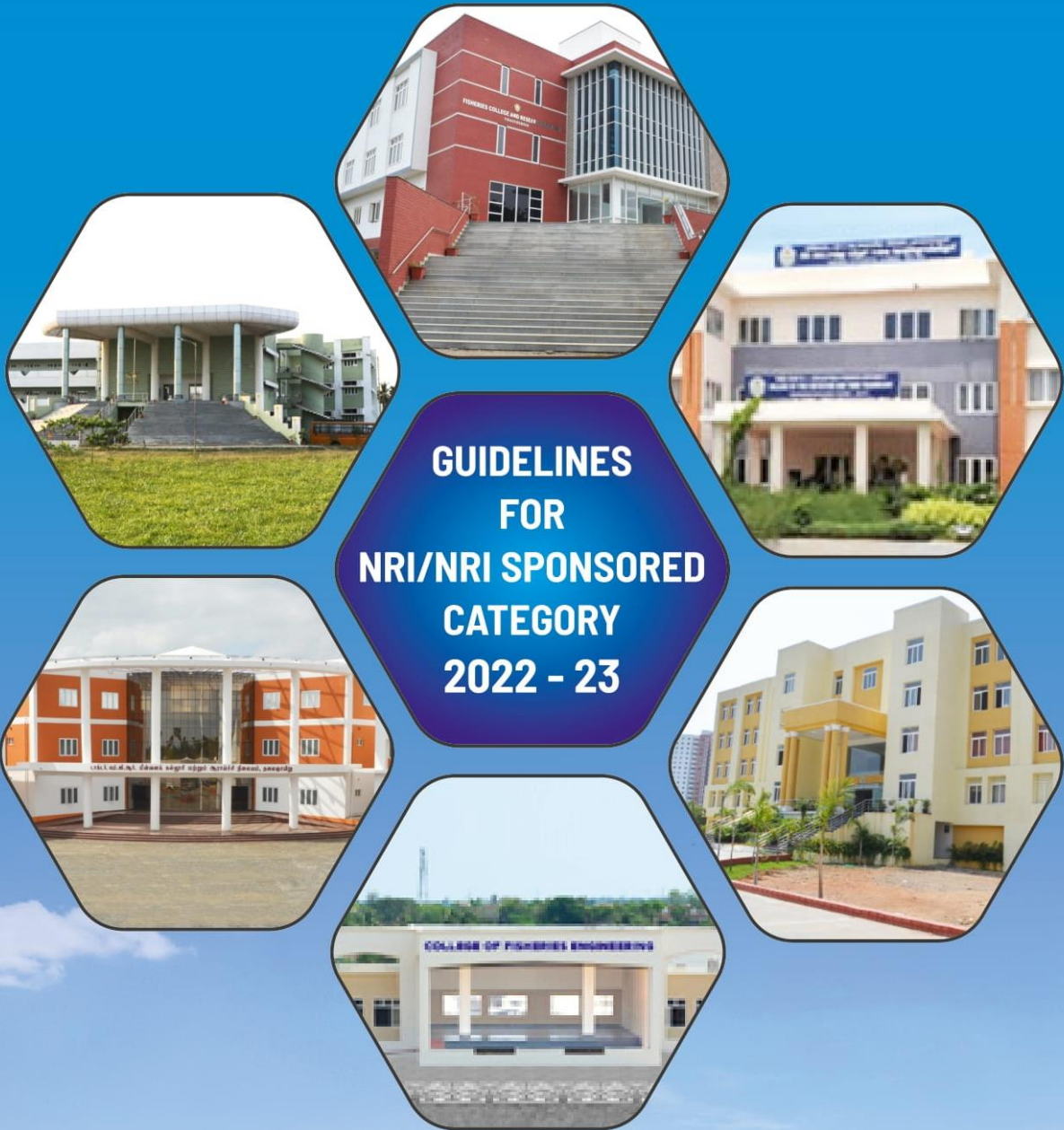

**GUIDELINES FOR NON-RESIDENT INDIANS (NRIs) /
NRI SPONSORED CATEGORY FOR
B.F.Sc. and B.TECH. (FISHERIES ENGINEERING) ADMISSION (2022-23)**

Course	Available seats
Bachelor of Fisheries Science (B.F.Sc.)	10*
B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering)	4

The seats reserved for Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) / NRI Sponsored Category are over and above the sanctioned admission strength of B.F.Sc. and B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) degree courses.

*If the seats are vacant in the Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) / NRI Sponsored Category, that vacant seats will automatically filled by the local candidates (Tamil Nadu) on merit basis under self-supporting mode.

I. Eligibility

Applicants must be NRI or NRI Sponsored Candidates (**Sponsored by NRI parents / parents' blood brother/sister and candidate's blood brother / sister**). NRI and wards of NRI must submit a certificate from competent authority in Specimen – I. NRI, who is financially supporting the candidate, needs to produce **Relationship Certificate** in Specimen - II as seen in the application.

a. Academic eligibility for admission to B.F.Sc:

Candidates must have completed 12 years (10+2) of school education of Indian System, i.e. HSC of State Board / CBSE / ISC or its equivalent. Candidates must have studied in English Medium (or have proficiency in English language) and obtained a pass in qualifying examination with good marks / grades in Biology / Zoology and Botany, Physics and Chemistry.

b. Academic eligibility for admission to B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering):

Candidates must have completed 12 years (10+2) of school education of Indian System, i.e. HSC of State Board / CBSE / ISC or its equivalent. Candidates must have studied in English Medium (or have proficiency in English language) and obtained a pass in qualifying examination with good marks / grades in Mathematics, Biology/ Computer Science, Physics and Chemistry.

II. Age limit

Candidates should not have completed 21 years as on 01-07-2022.

III. Application form

Online application form is available in the university website (www.tnjfu.ac.in).

IV. Submission of Application

The filled in application should be submitted online on or before **08.08.2022**. A copy of the downloaded filled in application along with attested photocopies of the relevant certificates given in the checklist should be sent to **The Chairman, UG Admission Committee, Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University, Vettar River View Campus, Nagapattinam - 611002, Tamil Nadu, India on or before 16.08.2022.**

Note: The checklist of certificates is provided with application form.

- Applications received after the due date will not be considered under any circumstances.
- If any of the required certificate is not enclosed, the application is liable for rejection summarily.

V. Application fee: US \$ 30 for each course

Application fee shall be paid online at the time of submission of online application.
Candidates applying for both the courses should pay US \$ 60.

VI. Selection of candidates

Selection will be based on the academic merit in the qualifying examination of the candidates applied for and the selection list will be hosted in the University website.

In case of a tie in the common merit list, the inter-se-merit among such students will be determined in the order of priority as specified below:

B.F.Sc course:

- Percentage of marks obtained in Biology or Zoology and Botany taken together
- Percentage of marks in Chemistry
- Percentage of marks in the Physics
- Date of birth: Seniority in age given preference

B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) course:

- Percentage of marks in Mathematics
- Percentage of marks in Physics
- Percentage of marks in Chemistry
- Percentage of marks in Biology / Computer Science
- Date of birth: Seniority in age given preference

VII. Original documents to be submitted at the time of admission by candidates belonging to NRI / NRI sponsored categories:

1. Recent NRI status certificate of the candidate / parent / sponsor issued by the Indian Embassy of the country concerned with their seal as per Specimen –I.
2. In case the candidate is financially supported NRI sponsor, the Relationship Certificate showing the relationship of the sponsor to the candidate as per Specimen- II.
3. Employment Certificate of the NRI parent / sponsor as per Specimen – III. In the case of self-employment, nature of business, annual income and proof thereof.
4. Proof of updated / recent NRI Bank account of the NRI parent / sponsor.
5. Photocopy of the Passport of the NRI candidate / NRI parent / sponsor.
6. Qualifying mark list of the candidate. If grades are produced, certificate showing equivalent marks to grades should be submitted.
7. Certificate showing that the candidate has undergone the qualifying school education in **English** medium.
8. Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate from the school last studied / equivalent certificate.
9. Two recent passport size photographs (in addition to photo affixed in the application)
10. Proof of date of birth
11. Proof of place of birth and nativity
12. Conduct certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last studied
13. Medical Fitness certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner, not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon.

VIII. Payment of Fees

On receipt of selection order, the candidate has to pay the Institutional Economic Fee and Development Fee, apart from usual fees, as prescribed by the University by demand draft in US Dollars drawn in favour of **"The Finance Officer, TNJFU, Nagapattinam"** payable at Nagapattinam, Tamil Nadu.

i) Institutional Economic Fee (in US Dollars)

Note: For extended period of study, an additional fee of US \$ 2,000 per annum needs to be paid.

ii) **Development fee** - US \$ 1,000 shall be paid at the time of admission.

iii) Other fees

Other regular semester fees (Tuition fee, Special fee, Examination fee, etc. as given in the table below) should be paid in Indian Rupees or its equivalent in US Dollars at the time of admission or when required to be paid, as per the rules of the University.

IX. System of Education – Semester Course Credit System

B.F.Sc. Degree Course (8 Semesters)

The pattern of instruction and evaluation is the semester course credit system under the syllabus and regulations prescribed by the ICAR. After completion of course credits at the VI semester, the student should satisfactorily complete the Student READY Programme in VII and VIII semesters. An enrolled student should complete the course credits prescribed from time to time and shall have to earn a minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 5.50 out of 10.00 in order to earn B.F.Sc. degree.

In addition to the above, the student shall, in the judgment of the faculty, possess good moral habits and high standards of honesty.

B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) Degree Course (8 semesters)

The pattern of instruction and evaluation is the Semester course credit system with six semesters of course work and two semesters of Student READY experiential learning that includes Rural Fisheries Engineering Work Experience (RFEWE), Educational Tour and Industrial Internship programme. An enrolled student should complete the course credits prescribed from time to time and shall have to earn a minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 5.50 out of 10.00 in order to earn the above degrees.

In addition to the above, the student shall, in the judgment of the faculty, possess good moral habits and high standards of honesty.

X. General Information

Reporting to the University

This year, the academic session shall ordinarily begin by **October or November**. Candidates selected for admission are required to report to the Dean of the college concerned on the scheduled date mentioned in the allotment order. If the candidate fails to do so, the offer of admission will automatically stand cancelled.

Hostel Accommodation

Hostel accommodation is available. Interested candidates may apply to the Dean of the college for Hostel accommodation after admission. They have to pay the prescribed fee as per Hostel Rules. The Hostel Mess is run on dividing system by the students.

All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. Admission shall be liable to cancellation at any stage during the study, if it is found that an admission was contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicants or their parents / sponsors at the time of admission. Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.

Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University reserves the right to cancel or vary any of these rules without notice.

XI. DISCONTINUING FROM THE DEGREE COURSES

Students those who are unable to continue the course on genuine reasons such as (i) Inability to pay the fees, (ii) getting Government jobs for their SSLC / HSC qualifications, (iii) becoming physically handicapped during the course of study and similar genuine cases will be permitted to discontinue. **All other cases who desires to leave the degree programme after the closure of UG admission (2022-23) or on any date of subsequent years irrespective of the fact, should pay a sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs or its equivalent US dollar (\$).**

The selected candidates and his/her parent/guardian will have to execute an agreement bond (Appendix IV & V) during admission. Failure to execute the agreement bond will lead to cancellation of selection.

XII. PREVENTION OF RAGGING

RAGGING IS PUNISHABLE AS PER PROCEEDINGS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA IN SLP (C) NO. 24295/2004 CONVEYED BY THE UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION VIDE LETTER NO. F.1-8/2006 (CPP-II) DATED: 04.03.2008.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if candidate explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel the candidate from the institution and liable for legal action.

All the candidates admitted under these categories should abide by the Academic Rules and Regulations prescribed in the Act, Statutes, Rules and Regulations (ASRR) of the University, which may be subject to revision from time to time.

Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University reserves the right to cancel or vary any of these rules without notice.

4. Proof of updated / recent NRI Bank account of the NRI parent / sponsor.
5. Photocopy of the Passport of the NRI candidate / NRI parent / sponsor.
6. Qualifying mark list of the candidate: if the grades are produced certificate showing equivalent marks to grades should be submitted.
7. Certificate showing that the candidate has undergone the qualifying school education in **English** medium.
8. Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate from the school last studied / equivalent certificate.
9. Proof of date of birth.
10. Proof of place of birth and nativity.
11. Conduct certificate issued by the Head of Institution last studied.
12. Two passport size photographs (in addition to photo affixed in the application).

Note: 1) The details of Health Insurance Policy and Vaccination particulars of the Candidate must be produced at the time of admission.

2) In the event of selection, Annexure - I (Declaration) and Annexure - II (Medical Certificate) should be produced at the time of admission.
